

International Day of People with Disabilities

In recognition of International Day of People with Disabilities, the FAAST program at Tampa General Hospital highlights the role of assistive technology in promoting this year's theme of inclusion, accessibility, and sustainability.

Assistive Technology

Assistive Technology (AT) devices are tools and strategies to help individuals with disabilities of all ages to participate more independently in school, work, play, and life. These include:

- Communication Devices: voice output devices and communication apps
- Vision Devices: magnifiers, talking prescription bottles and screen reading programs
- Hearing Devices: amplified phones, assisted listening and FM systems
- Environmental Control Systems to operate lights, devices and appliances through switch, voice or phone activation
- Learning Tools: adaptive switch toys, sensory toys, interactive apps and built-up writing instruments
- Computer Adaptations: modified keyboards, voice and mouse options
- Aids For Daily Living: built-up spoons, dressing aids and jar openers
